

ABSTRACT

One of the strategies to minimize corruption and to make the government more accountable is by improving information transparency. The government's Web pages, if managed well, can play its roles in improving information transparency in Indonesia.

From the research, it is found that some public information could be accessed from the Web pages. Technically, the Web pages' quality of design is good enough. The types of fonts used, the quality of photographs, and the graphic illustrations are already good enough.

The Web pages are also acceptable enough. Fairly, the Web pages are interesting, systematic, and understandable. Even though public information in the Web pages is more complete than the printed format and accessing public information in the Web pages is faster, the perceived of information transparency in the Web pages is not adequate yet.

*It is also found that the Web pages' quality of design significantly influences acceptability of the Web pages. Moreover, acceptability of the Web pages influences the perceived of information transparency in the Web pages significantly. Therefore, to improve the perceived of information transparency, acceptability of the Web pages must be improved firstly. To improve the acceptability of the Web pages, the Web pages' quality of design must be improved firstly.****
